Lunging **ONLY** in the Livestock Arena (absolutely **no lunging** in the warm-up area).

RIDERS MUST DISPLAY THE LETTER (M) BEFORE THEIR MARC BRIDLE NOS.

Please display two **bridle numbers** when competing. This means you do not need to report to the judge before your test, just ride past the judge's car to enable the writer to take note of your number. This will speed up the flow of tests.

We will be using the Nominate Livescore program so there will be no paper tests available.

Presentation will take place at end of each day **after** arena has been packed away.
