Two official days were held in March and June, with the Star Championships once again being very successful. We ran our first club Championship in October and though low numbers it really was a lot of fun for all involved and the plan is to continue this year again. At each of these events all tests were well supported with some very good scores, which I think is a testament to not only the exceptional facilities that we are able to use for these events but also because so many of the club members assist in making the days run smoothly and professionally. This has been especially rewarding when I hear about the struggles of many rural clubs in attracting competitors and finding enough helpers. A variety of sponsorship was collected for the Championships and this has been able to be carried over to the 2024 event.

This is a very important event for Dressage and the Fraser Coast Community. We value and welcome any sponsorship (financial or prizes) that can be given to support this wonderful local event

New Dressage Rule Changes

There are some changes to the Dressage Rules effective from 1st January 2024. Most are minor "tweaking" of existing Rules, however there is one significant change which affects all competitors i.e.

A **Gear Check** by an EA-Accredited Steward is **compulsory immediately** <u>after</u> every test and failure to have a gear check will entail **elimination**. (Previously, the gear check needed to be done before competing.)

To assist riders, a visual gear check may be done by the Steward *before* the test to prevent a rider going into the test with any forbidden equipment. (It still remains the rider's responsibility not to compete with any forbidden equipment, so it is a good idea to know the rules and/or seek advice from a Steward before competing.

NOTE: Even if riders present to the Steward for a visual gear check *before* entering a test, it is **still compulsory** for them **to present again** to the Steward for gear check **immediately after every** test or they will be eliminated!

A few other Rule Reminders:

- Don't talk to or 'tongue click' your horse during the test any judge who hears it will deduct 2 marks for every movement that they hear it!
- Riders must wear gloves
- Pony riders check the size of your whip and/or spurs which are smaller than for horses.

**It is also a requirement that there must have an accredited person with a First Aid Certificate at each event. MARC will refund 50% of the cost of training for MARC members who complete a First Aid Certificate. Members who have current accreditation include:

Riders will get a timed draw with 20 minutes to practice riding tests or test movements under the guidance of an EA Accredited Judge or experienced MARC riders.

Tell the judge/helper which test/s or movements you want to practice, or you can choose to practice in the arena without advice if you prefer.

Also, come along to a Group Chat over the morning tea break under the shady trees

- discuss common problems and hints to improve your tests
- understanding scores and Judge's comments

Judges don't have time to comment on all the good/bad aspects of each movement, so comments meant to provide constructive hints can appear as criticism. Sometimes riders are unsure what the Judges' comments mean, so bring some examples if you don't understand them.
