Entries will be through Nominate www.nominate.com.au and there will be a limit of 30 tests. We will be using the Livescore program so there will be no paper test sheets.

<u>Please do not complete an entry unless your horse has a bridle number.</u> If you do not have a bridle number, please contact Roslyn Barker on email <u>roslyn.barker@gmail.com</u> and she will allocate one to your horse. Bridle numbers speed up the flow of tests and must be used at all of our dressage competitions.

*Horse health forms must be submitted before competing.

Helmets must be yellow tagged before riding.

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per test + \$10.50 facility fee per horse.

Stables are \$16.00 with a bond payment and must be made at least 48hrs before the commencement of the event through nominate

<u>Please do not complete an entry unless your horse has a bridle number</u>. If your horse does not have an EA bridle number, please contact Roslyn Barker on email roslyn.barker@gmail.com</u> and she will allocate one to your horse. Bridle numbers are essential for electronic scoring.

 Full membership enables participation at all MARC events while Limited Membership enables participation at 3 days at MARC events for the year.
 - > Horse health declaration form must be brought to the event and handed to secretary office before competing.
 - As the Event is run under current EA rules, the onus is on the on the rider to understand these rules before they compete. Gear check has now become compulsory (immediately) AFTER the test!!
 - > Max of 3 EA/Particiapant classes per horse or 2 FEI classes per horse over 2 consecutive levels and max 2 horses per rider.
